All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Rewari, an Institute of National Importance, is one of the new AIIMS and apex healthcare Institute under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) which has been established by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, with the aim of correcting regional imbalance in quality tertiary level healthcare in the country, and attaining self-sufficiency in graduate, postgraduate and higher medical education and training.

Offline applications from Indian citizens/persons registered as Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholder under Section 7A of the Citizenship Act, 1955 as permissible under the applicable Act/Rules are invited for the following faculty posts on Direct Recruitment Basis in various departments of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Rewari.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The AIIMS, Rewari reserves the right to increase or decrease or not to fill up any post(s) without assigning any reason. The Competent Authority reserves the right to amend, cancel or change this advertisement as a whole or in part without assigning any reason or giving notice.
2. The posts are whole time and private practice of any kind is strictly prohibited.
3. All posts carry usual allowances as admissible to Central Government Employees of similar status at Majra, Rewari, Haryana.
4. Applicants must possess the essential qualification and experience up to the last date of submission of application(s). Their candidature will be cancelled at any stage if it is found that their educational qualifications or experiences is/are not genuine.
5. **SELECTION PROCESS:** Selection is based on performance in the Interview. However, written test or screening, based on objective criteria, may be done to shortlist applicants to be called for interview.

The decision of the Competent Authority regarding shortlisting of candidates to be called for interview, would be final and binding on all candidates.

6. **MODE OF INTERVIEW:** For interview, a candidate has to appear *in person*. No request for an online interview i.e., through electronic media will be accepted and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the interview.
7. Canvassing of any kind will be a disqualification.
8. The candidate should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.
9. All disputes will be subject to jurisdiction of a Court of Law at Rewari, Haryana/ High Court of Punjab and Haryana.

11. ELIGIBILITY NORMS:

- a) The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must fulfill eligibility criteria as on or before 19th June 2026 i.e. should have passed qualifying exam for essential education qualification / have completed the required duration of experience as given in Recruitment Rules on or before last date. In those cases where one passes exam or complete duration of experience after this date, their candidature will stand cancelled.
- b) Candidates must attach the documents/certificates in support of all the claims made by them in the application like Date of Birth, Experience (in sequence as mentioned in application), Essential qualification(s), Caste certificate/EWS certificate/Disability proof or any other information as applicable in their case, separately against each claim.
- c) Matriculation/10th Standard or equivalent certificate indicating date of birth, or mark sheet of Matriculation/10th Standard or equivalent issued by Central /State Board indicating Date of Birth should be submitted in support of claim of age.
- d) **Education Qualification certificates:** As per Recruitment Rules for the post applied must be enclosed. In case of those who have equivalent educational qualification, Order/ letter regarding equivalent Educational Qualification claimed, indicating the Authority (with number and date) under which it has been so treated, regarding equivalent clause in Essential Qualifications, if a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the requirement of advertisement. The equivalent qualification will be decided by the Competent Authority of AIIMS, Rewari and his decision will be final in this regard.

- e) **Experience Certificate:** Should be from the Head(s) of Organization (for the period of experience claimed, clearly showing the, duration of experience (“from” to “to”), Nature of experience (either teaching and/or research). Teaching / research experiences which are gained in organization recognized by MCI/NMC/UGC recognized teaching institutions will only be considered. Experience acquired after having acquired requisite essential qualification for the applied post will only be considered to determine eligibility as per recruitment rule for the post.
- f) **DNB equivalence:** In cases of those who are holding DNB in broad specialties or super specialty as essential qualifying education, they have to produce documentary evidence issued by Competent Authority about DNB equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch as per NMC New Delhi notification dated 14.02.2022. (The Diplomate of National Board (DNB) in broad specialty and super specialty qualifications when granted in a medical institution with attached hospital or in a hospital with the strength of **five hundred or more beds**, by the National Board of Examinations, shall be equivalent in all respects to the corresponding broad specialty (MD/MS) and super specialty (DM/MCh) postgraduate qualification, but in all other cases, senior residency in a medical college for an additional period of one year shall be required for such qualification to be equivalent for the purpose of teaching.)
- g) **SC/ST/OBC/PwBD/EWS Certificate:** Candidates applying for any of the reserved category posts, viz. SC/ST/OBC/PwBD/EWS will be considered subject to Caste/PwBD/EWS certificate issued by the appropriate/Competent Authority in the prescribed format. Community should be clearly and legibly mentioned in the Certificate.
- h) **OBC Candidates:**
- a. Candidates applying under the OBC category must submit a valid caste certificate in the format prescribed by the DoPT vide OM No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res.) dated 30.05.2014 and further clarified by OM No. 36036/2/2013-Estt (Res-I) dated 31.03.2016.
 - b. The certificate must mention the non-creamy layer status of the applicant (Non- Creamy layer status by an authority mentioned in DOPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93- Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993). The OBC applicants who belong to the ‘Non-Creamy layer ‘ and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs (notified by the Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes available at the website <http://ncbc.nic.in>), shall be eligible to be considered under the OBC category.
 - c. Non-creamy layer certificate issued in year 2026-27 will be valid for this recruitment.
 - d. If the applicant does not have the non-creamy layer Certificate issued during 2026-27 at the time of submission of application, the applicant must attach the previously issued (older) OBC certificate & non-creamy layer certificate or the acknowledgement slip issued by the authority where the applicant has submitted an application for the issue of a OBC and/or Non-Creamy Layer certificate for FY 2026-27.
 - e. Those candidates who submit proof of belonging to OBC category & certificate of belonging to Non-Creamy Layer (which has not been issued in FY 2026-27), will be provisionally allowed to appear in the interview as OBC candidate (if they are otherwise eligible to be shortlisted).
 - f. These candidates will be allowed to join only on production of valid NCL certificate which has been issued in year 2026-27. NCL certificate must have a reference of his /her original caste certificate.
- i) **PwBD Candidates:** All the above-mentioned posts are identified suitable for PwBD candidates and 4% of the total vacancies are horizontally reserved for PwBD candidates as per the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment’s Notification No. 16-15/2010-DD.III dated 29th July, 2013

as amended from time to time as applicable. Only those persons would be eligible for reservation under PwBD category, who have not less than 40% of disability. Person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation should submit a Disability Certificate issued by a Competent Authority in prescribed format as per “Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016”. The candidature of PwBD applicant is subject to evaluation by the Medical Board duly constituted by the Executive Director, AIIMS, Rewari. This board will evaluate suitability of candidates for the post one is being considered for.

- j) **NOC Certificate:** No Objection Certificate from the present employer (in case of regular candidates working in Government/Semi or Quasi Government, Government enterprises or Government funded autonomous institutions) is mandatory. Those who fail to produce NOC will not be allowed to appear for the interview for the post. Therefore, candidates are advised to attach NOC along with application or alternatively must produce it at the time of interview failing which he/she shall not be interviewed. Candidates, who are working as contractual employee in Government/Semi- Government/PSUs/Autonomous Bodies or any institution funded by Government, also have to produce NOC mandatorily. In case of change in employment status on or before interview/selection process due to any reasons, they have to take fresh permission from their new employer before interview and they also have to submit fresh NOC from their new employer.
- k) **Application for more than one post:** In case a candidate wishes to apply for more than one post, he/she is required to fill in the form separately for each post and deposit application fees separately along with each application.

- n) The self-attested copies of the following documents should be sent along with the application form:
- a. The Application Form and candidate’s brief in prescribed format
 - b. Mark-sheets and degrees.
 - c. Proof of Age / Date of Birth.
 - d. Caste/Category Certificate for ST/SC/OBC/EWS/PwBD (in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India)
 - e. Experience Certificate.
 - f. No Objection Certificate (NOC) for candidates working in Central/State Govt. Organizations/PSUs/Autonomous Bodies.
 - g. Two passport size Photographs.
 - h. Any other relevant documents.

- o) **Failure to submit the hard copy by due date of submission i.e. on or before 19th June, 2026 will lead to cancellation of the candidature.**
- p) Applications which are not complete in all respects, or applications where application fee is not submitted will be rejected without any communication. Therefore, to avoid rejection of their application, candidates are requested to make sure that application fee is paid, application is complete in all respect before they finally submit the application.
- q) **Document Verification:** All the original certificates/documents will be verified at the time of interview. The shortlisted candidate(s) who are called for interview should bring their duly filled-in and signed application form, a set of self-attested photocopies of all documents enclosed with application along with original certificates / documents. (i) 10th class, (ii) essential educational qualifications and experience certificate/s, (iii) Caste/EWS/PwBD certificate as applicable. Failure to produce these certificates/documents on the day of verification of documents/interview will lead to cancellation of candidature and candidate will not be allowed to appear for interview. List of certificates which must be produced in original are as under (**Annexure – II: List of Enclosures**):
- i. 10th/Matriculation Certificate from a recognized board - as proof of date of birth.
 - ii. Degree Certificate of essential qualifications as per Recruitment Rules.
 - iii. In case of those who are holding DNB in broad specialties or super specialty as qualifying education, their DNB course should be equivalent to MD/MS or DM/M.Ch. in specialties and super- specialties. As per NMC New Delhi notification dated 14.02.2022 the Diplomate of National Board (DNB) in broad specialty and super specialty qualifications when granted in a medical institution with attached hospital or in a hospital with the strength of five hundred or more beds, by the National Board of Examinations, shall be equivalent in all respects to the corresponding broad specialty (MD/MS) and super specialty (DM/MCh) postgraduate qualification, but in all other cases, senior residency in a medical college for an additional period of one year shall be required for such qualification to be equivalent for the purpose of teaching.
 - iv. Certificate of Registration with Medical Council of India, whichever is applicable.
 - v. Certificate of belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWBD category wherever applicable in the prescribed format issued by Competent/appropriate authority.
 - vi. Experience Certificate showing that you have possessed the requisite number of years of teaching and/or research experience on last date of submission of application as prescribed for each post, from MCI/other recognized Institution(s) as applicable, subject to following:
 1. Teaching/Research experience acquired only after post graduate qualification/Ph.D. as applicable in the specialty will be considered.
 2. Those who have DNB as qualifying degree, will need to have 1-year extra experience i.e. total 4 years from MCI recognized/permitted institution for equivalence if the bed strength of institution or hospital where one did DNB training is less than five hundred (500).
 3. Teaching experience to be counted for the applied post, should be in the concerned specialty from NMC/MCI recognized medical college (in cases where NMC/MCI recognition is from a particular year, experience prior to that will not be considered). Likewise, Post Graduate experience acquired in NMC/MCI recognized institution (recognized for MBBS course or if only award PG degree, then NMC should have recognized PG course in the specialty where he/she acquired experience) will only be considered valid.

12. **PAY SCALES:** Allowances are as applicable and pay scales are as below:

13. **PROBATION:** Period of probation for all faculty posts is two years.

14. The employees of the AIIMS will be governed by the New Pension Scheme as per the provision contained in the Ministry of Finance, Department of Economic Affairs (ECB & PR Division) Notification No. 5/7/2003-ECB&PR dated 22.12.2003.

15. **JOINING TIME** will be 30 days from the issue of appointment letter. Extension in joining time will be considered, only in exceptional cases, with the approval of Competent Authority, AIIMS, Rewari. If one is selected / offered against more than one post, when he/she joins against offered post & opts to change, he/she will not be allowed to change.

16. **STUDY COURSE:** A Candidate who is pursuing any program e.g. M.Ch./DM/Fellowships etc. while applying for the post, he/she shall be allowed to join only if he/she has completed the course on or before the last date of joining given in the offer letter. No request to allow to join as faculty and continue to pursue the course will be considered. Any request for extension in joining time to complete such a course will summarily be rejected.

17. **RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION** There is provision of providing residential accommodation to the faculty appointed at the AIIMS. However, in view of the paucity of the residential accommodation in the campus, it may not be possible to provide accommodation soon after joining. In the event that no accommodation is provided, necessary House Rent Allowance (H.R.A) as admissible to the Central Government Servants of similar status stationed at Majra, Rewari, Haryana will be provided as per rules.

18. **MAXIMUM AGE-LIMIT AND AGE RELAXATION:**

- 50 (Fifty) years for all posts.
- Cut-off date for determining eligibility in terms of age shall be the last date of submission of applications.
- No age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying for unreserved vacancies or if SC/ST/OBC candidates are considered against UR post on merit. The age concession to the PwBD shall be admissible irrespective of the fact whether the post is reserved for PwBD or not.
- Age relaxation permissible to various categories is as under:

* Age relaxation will be admissible only to regular employees working under Central Government provided a certificate to this effect by the employer in the format prescribed in **Annexure III** is produced by the government servant. Age relaxation will not be applicable to those working under Autonomous Body / State Government / PSU.

**** Definition of 'Ex-Serviceman':**

An 'ex-serviceman' means a person—

1. who has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union, and

1A. who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension; or

1B. who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or

1C. who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment.

2. Personnel of the Territorial Army: Pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service;

3. Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal Service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstances beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension;

4. Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1987;

5. Gallantry award winners of the Armed Forces including personnel of Territorial Army;

6. Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.

e) **Maximum Age Limit after Relaxation:** The upper age limit, even after availing age relaxation, shall not surpass 55 years on the cut-off date.

20. **PHOTO & SIGNATURE:** The candidate must ensure that their recent passport size photograph is affixed on the application form at the designated place and that their signature is appended at all required places. 24. **INCLUSION IN SELECTED LIST CONFERS NO RIGHT TO APPOINTMENT:** - The inclusion of a candidate's name in the Selected list confers no right to appointment unless the Competent Authority is satisfied, after such enquiry as may be considered necessary, that the candidate having regard to his/her character and antecedents is suitable in all respects for appointment to the Service.
25. **DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT ON MEDICAL GROUNDS:** - Candidate shall be appointed to the Service, only if, after such medical examination, as the Institute may prescribe, he/she is found to be in good mental or bodily health and free from any mental or physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the Service.
26. **ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:** Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information in filling up the application form and any documents in the recruitment process. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case correct or alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or its attested/certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document.
